Group work and thinking time is exciting especially when we are all sharing ideas.



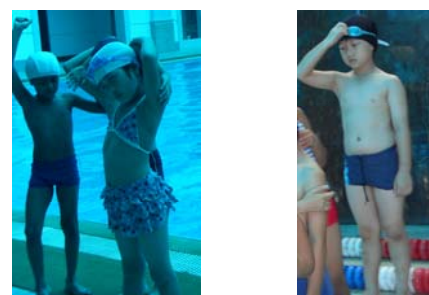
